

Background

Alupe University (AU) is located approximately 7 kilometres from Busia town on the Busia-Malaba Road and 23 Kilometres from Malaba Town which are both border towns linking

Kenya and Uganda.

The University is situated on a 200-acre piece of land and is currently the only Public University

in Busia County.

AU is a product of a memorandum handed to former President of Kenya, His Excellency Hon. Mwai Kibaki, on 18th September 2007 by the Busia Community. It began as the Alupe Campus of Moi University in 2008. Later, it was established through the Alupe University College Order 2015. Gazette Notice No.153 of 24th July 2015 as a

the Alupe University College Order 2015, Gazette Notice No153 of 24th July 2015 as a Constituent College of Moi University after a wide range of intergovernmental and ministerial consultations.

On the 2nd of August 2022, the journey to full status as a Chartered University was realised upon the award of Charter by His Excellency former President Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta C.G.H. at State Lodge Kakamega.

The University currently has four schools, that is, School of Health Sciences, School of Science, Technology and Engineering, School of Education and Social Sciences, and School of Business, Economics and Human Resource Development.

In its neighbourhood are internationally renowned research institutions including the Kenya Medical Research Institute (KEMRI), Kenya Agriculture and Livestock Research Organization (KALRO) and the Lake Basin Development Authority (LBDA). The proximity of these institutions provide partnership and collaborative opportunities for teaching, research and extension services to the Kenyan population.

Good health and well-being are increasingly becoming a focus of governments, policy makers and researchers as we face diverse and multifaceted challenges in the 21st century. At the same time, growth in interventions that focus on well-being rather than disease have led to the potential for integrative, diverse and holistic approaches being adopted in the training of health professionals. Our undergraduate degree programmes in Public Health, Medical Psychology, Medical Laboratory sciences and Physical Therapy are developed to produce a health professional that is capable of addressing the modern health and social challenges through a multidisciplinary, interdisciplinary, systemic and community engaged solutions.

The School also offers post-graduate (Masters and PhD) level programmes in Public Health (MPH) and MSc. Medical Microbiology. In the 2024/2025 Academic Year, the School will commence the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN degree).

Our mission is to produce competent health professionals who have practical and intellectual skills appropriate to the health and development needs of current and future generations. The School believes in training our students in a setting as similar to what they encounter in real life by fostering a strong team spirit and community engagement in the delivery of health services. Our students spend about 30% of their training time in community based education and experiences, where skills and values of teamwork, clinical practice, community service and research are internalized and practised. The mission of the school is delivered by a highly trained team of specialized professionals in Public Health, Behavioral Sciences; Medical Biochemistry, Hematology and Blood transfusion; Histopathology and Cytology; parasitology and immunology; and Physiotherapy

Being a science focused institution, the School has well-equipped laboratories for teaching and research which have been provided through a partnership with the Seeding Labs Inc., USA. The School has on-going collaborations on research, training, student and staff exchange programmes with Vives University in Belgium; Manchester University in the UK, County Governments and KEMRI.

The Lake Region Economic Block (LREB) has identified the School as a Centre of excellence for training medical laboratory scientists.

Our graduates are on high demand and most have found placement within the health sector including county and national governments, research institutions, private sector, Public Benefit Organizations and institutions of higher learning.

Critical thinking, complex and creative problem solving, active learning, and interpersonal skills are developed through classroom, laboratory, and field experiences with faculty who are committed to sharing their experience and passion for science with students. Furthermore, the school offers a unique interpersonal experience with learners where each student is attached to an academic advisor in the school to ensure that the students are properly trained both academically and in all other aspects of life. The school has fully functional equipped laboratory facilities and specialized equipment for each of the departments.

The school offers the following programs for both undergraduate and postgraduate students: Bachelor of Science in Computer Science, Bachelor of Science in Applied Statistics with Computing and Bachelor of Science in Microbiology. In addition, it also offers diploma in Analytical Chemistry, Applied Biology and Information Communication Technology.

In its plan and in response to the needs of society, the School will start the following new programs in the 2024/2025 academic year: Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Education and Extension (AGED), Bachelor of Science in Analytical Chemistry and Bachelor of Science in Information Technology. The School of Education and Social Sciences (SESS) is one of the four Schools in Alupe University. The School also collaborates closely with industry to offer attachment and job placement in various institutions such as the Prisons Service, Department of Health at the county governments, hospitals, schools and other agencies, all for the professional development of our students that will see them participate in the development of the nation, leading to the achievement of the latter's transformative agenda.


